Only currently enrolled 6^{th} , 7^{th} , and 8^{th} grade wrestlers will be eligible to compete in the tournament. All teams must be Governing Board approved.

ENTRIES

All teams must pre-register with one of the Tournament Directors by January 13, 2023. ALL entries are due on Monday, January 22nd at noon. All teams are required to submit their roster online via TrackWrestling – coaches will need a login and password, obtained from Tournament Staff (azjhstate@gmail.com). Any changes after Thursday, January 25th at 5:00 pm cannot be guaranteed to be accepted, including weight class and/or name changes, although we will do our best to accommodate.

This is a double-elimination tournament; all wrestlers are guaranteed 2 matches

SEEDING

Wednesday, January 24th via Google Meets beginning at 5:00 pm (invite to be sent to the seeding committee on Monday, January 22nd). Up to eight (8) wrestlers per weight class will be seeded according to the following criteria:

- 1. 2024 Tempe State placing
- 2. 2023-2024 head-to-head results
- 3. 2023-2024 record specifically quality wins and losses
- 4. Current and past tournament placements (Copper State and Tempe State)
- 5. Decision by the seeding committee and/or Tournament Directors

TRAINER Certified medical staff will be present at the tournament

Order of the finals will be determined by selecting at random, the weight class to be conducted first and then proceeding sequentially from that weight class (e.g., 125 is drawn, it will be the first weight class wrestled, then 133, 142, etc.)
