- ELIGIBILITY** *Only girls enrolled in the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade will be eligible to compete in the open girls tournament. If a girl is also a member of a school-based team, they much choose to wrestle in the school-based side OR the open girls side - they cannot wrestle in BOTH tournaments.*
All open girls entries MUST be prepared to provide a document of proof of current grade enrollment in a school in **Arizona; home-schooled girls must provide proof of domicile in the state of Arizona

Onsite entries will be accepted the day of the tournament at a higher fee (\$45).
Only 16 entries per weight class will be accepted so register now!

RULES	2021-2022 National Federation rules will apply.
FORMAT	School Side and an Open Girls Side
COST	\$35 Pre-registration; \$45 Onsite Entry Fee
WEIGHT CLASEES	70, 76, 83, 90, 98, 106, 115, 125, 135, 150, 175, 220 (Only 16 wrestlers per weight class will be allowed to register)
ELIGIBILITY	*Only girls enrolled in the 6 th , 7 th , and 8 th grade will be eligible to compete in the open girls tournament. If a girl is also a member of a school-based team, they much choose to wrestle in either or both the school-based side and the open girls side.
AWARDS	*Medals and garments (Champion T-shirt) to the top four wrestlers in each weight class *Outstanding wrestler (2) awards
TIMES	Wrestling starts at approximately 11 am run concurrently with the school side
RULES	National Federation State High School rules apply. Only certified officials will be used
WEIGH-INS	<u>Saturday, Jan. 29th</u> (in the warm-up area) at 9:00 am ***All wrestlers must weigh-in wearing their competition singlet***
PERIOD TIMES	Championship rounds: 1-2-2 Consolation rounds: 1-1-1 <i>This is a double-elimination tournament; all wrestlers are guaranteed 2 matches</i>
SEEDING	Wrestlers will be separated by school/club. Beyond that, we plan to seed wrestlers based on the information we have available to us, including their 2021-2022 record. Any and all information wrestlers, coaches, and/or parents can provide for potential seeds would be appreciated. We will especially lean on 2022 Tempe and other major tournament (Tulsa) results.
TRAINER	Certified medical staff will be present at the tournament
SNACK BAR	Various food stands will be operating during the tournament, inside the venue, none of which are associated with the tournament but are independently operated. <i>We are terribly sorry but a hospitality room is not allowed at the FTC due to their contract with food vendors.</i>

FINALS (Saturday, ≈ 5:00 pm): 1st through 4th place matches (2 mats)

Order of the finals will be determined by selecting at random, the weight class to be conducted first and then proceeding sequentially from that weight class (e.g., 125 is drawn, it will be the first weight class wrestled, then 133, 142, etc.)
